(September 29, 2010) – Michael Annett's Germain Racing Toyota Camry will carry a special paint scheme for a portion of the final stretch of 2010 races beginning with this weekend's NASCAR Nationwide Series Kansas Lottery 300 at Kansas Speedway. Race day kicks off with Nationwide Series qualifying at 10:05 a.m. and the green flag waves for the start of the Kansas Lottery 300 at 3:30 p.m. Tune to ESPN 2 and MRN Radio at 3 p.m. for live coverage of Saturday's race.
